

# **OCTOBER 30, 2017 STORM CLEAN-UP**

Andover DPW crews are working diligently to manage the debris from the storm that occurred on October 30, 2017. Town of Andover crews are working with NGRID and other utilities to clear trees, brush and other debris from public ways. The following is helpful information for residents about the options for managing their trees and brush downed by the storm in their own yards:

## **Bald Hill Composting Facility – Closing Date Extended!!!**

Residents may purchase a Bald Hill Composting Facility permit for \$25 per year to bring their brush to the Town's Bald Hill Composting Facility. We accept trees and brush up to 6" in diameter and 4' in length, and it must not contain any metal or plastic debris. We do not accept trees or brush from private contractors. We will EXTEND the closing of the Bald Hill Composting Site until December 3, 2017, weather permitting.

## **Curbside**

Republic Services will pick up brush at the curb. Twigs/branches up to 6" in diameter and 4' in length are allowed in the weekly trash pickup. Bundles must weigh 50 lbs or less and a limit of four bundles per week is allowed.
