Elderly Complexes: Three of the four complexes are located by the Morton Street office: Chestnut Court, Grandview Terrace and Stowe Court. The fourth complex, Frye Circle, is located at 256 N. Main Street. All complexes include one bedroom, one living area serving as a kitchen/livingroom (or one small kitchen with separate small living room) and a bathroom. **If you are requesting a first floor, you must attach a physician's note stating that it is necessary for you to live on the first floor. We do not have any elevators.**

Family Complex: Located on Memorial Circle includes apartments with two floors. The downstairs has a kitchen and livingroom, and in the 3 or 4 bedroom apartments, may have one bedroom. The 2nd floor has the bathroom and bedroom(s). We have 2, 3, and 4 bedroom units. The bedroom size is selected by the fact that a household may choose a unit with enough bedrooms so that two people do not share a bedroom unless:

- A. They are husband and wife
- B. A single parent with a child under eight.
- C. Children under eight, regardless of sex.

Veteran's Preference is available in the Family Conventional Housing Development and will be given to families applying for conventional housing if official verification of character and length of service of the veteran is provided with the application. Veteran's preference is only given for elderly/disabled housing if you are also an Andover resident. (Attached is Definition of Mass. Veteran)

Special Needs Housing: If you are a handicapped person, you may qualify for a specially designated apartment. You should submit complete medical information concerning the nature of your handicap and the architectural design feature, which you require in order to live independently.

Emergency Housing: If you are homeless, through no fault of your own, you may request an application for Emergency Assistance.

Notification:

Within approximately ten days you will receive a written statement telling you if you are eligible or ineligible for the waiting list. The housing authority will verify all information.

Any false statement may invalidate the application.

Please note that one of the enclosed forms is an Authorization for Release of Information to be signed by all adult applicants.
