The Andover Health Department has announced activities set to recognize National Public Health Week, April 6th through 10th. Public Health Week celebrates the work local health departments do on a day-to-day basis to care for the citizens they serve.

Adult Immunization Clinics will be held throughout the month of April at the Health Department.

Free Pneumococcal vaccinations will be offered to adults who smoke and adults with asthma. Call the Health Department for information and an appointment.

Free Tetanus and Pertussis (Whooping Cough) vaccinations will also be offered. These are recommended especially for all new parents and grandparents and healthcare workers.

Blood Pressure and Wellness Clinic will be conducted on Wednesday April 8th at the Andover Senior Center from 2:00 to 3:00 pm. No appointment necessary.

Throughout the week, a Public Health Display and Information Table will be set up on the second floor of the Andover Town Offices and at the Memorial Hall Library. Information will focus on Immunizations, Prostate Cancer and Melanoma.
