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## ANDOVER COVID-19 CASE DATA REPORT DATE: October 1, 2021

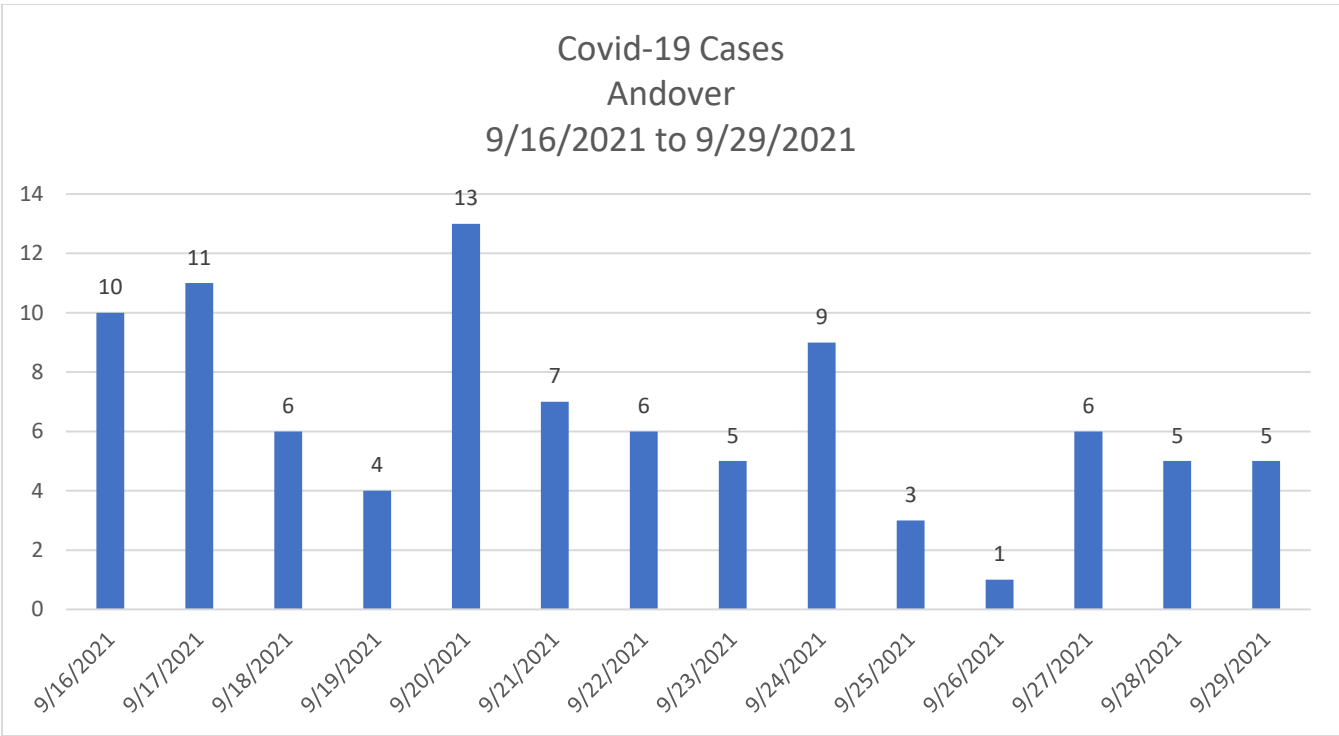
Due to the increase in positive Covid-19 Cases in both the country and the Commonwealth, the town has been receiving questions about cases in Andover. This data is being supplied to help residents and businesses make informed decisions about how they protect those around them.

This data is for September 16 to September 22, 2021:

**Items to Note:**

- Weekly case counts declined this week by more than a third.
- Data is showing that this week there is no pattern concerning vaccinated versus unvaccinated cases.
- Cases are occurring in all age groups.
- We are seeing evidence of household spread.
- Essex County is still an area of high transmission according to the CDC.

**Precautions to Take:**

- If you have not been vaccinated, or have not completed your vaccination series, **do so now**. To find a vaccination clinic, click here: <https://www.mass.gov/covid-19-vaccine>.

- If you are unvaccinated, you should wear a face covering inside public spaces and elsewhere, where crowds might be located.
- Fully vaccinated persons should consider wearing a face covering when entering crowded indoor spaces.

- If you have been identified as a close contact of a positive person, consider being tested no sooner than 5 days after you last exposure to that person. To find a test site, visit <https://www.mass.gov/info-details/find-a-covid-19-test>.

### **Face Covering Guidance:**

- If you are unvaccinated, you should wear a mask.
- On Public Transportation and Ride Shares, all persons **MUST** wear face coverings.
- You **MUST** wear a face covering inside a medical facility and congregate care facilities.
- If you are immunocompromised, even if vaccinated, you should wear a mask in crowded areas.
- If you reside with a person who is immunocompromised, you should wear a mask in crowded areas.
- If you are at increased risk for severe disease because of age or weakened immune system, you should wear a mask indoors when not at home.
