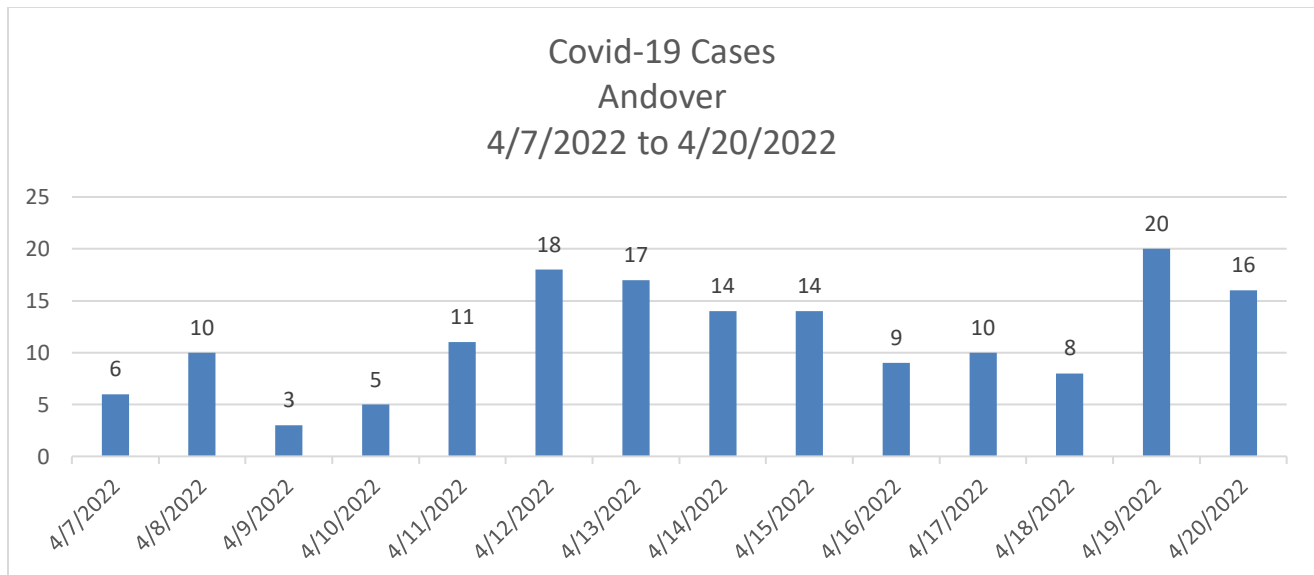

### FAQs:

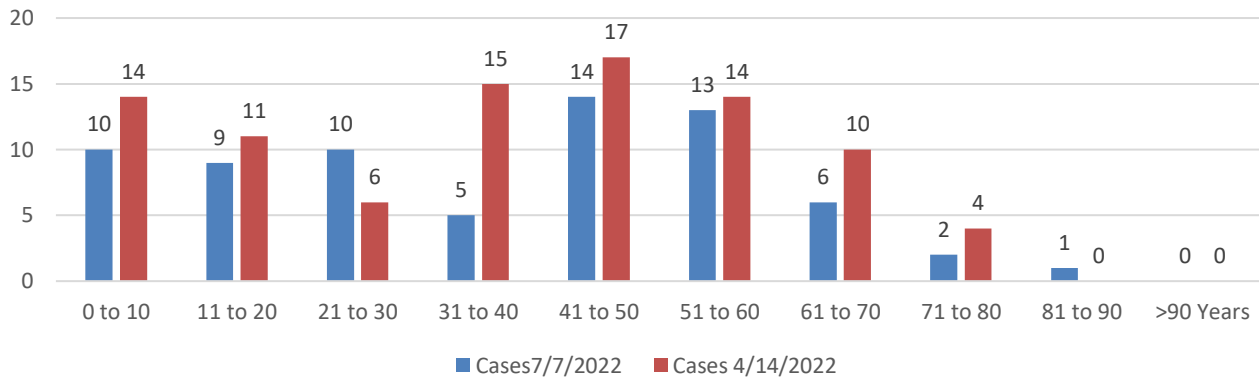
- I used an at-home test kit and tested positive; where should I report these results? – The results are not reportable to the town, and would not be included in these case counts.
- Should I have an additional test done if my home test is positive? – Yes, we recommend seeking a PCR test to confirm the home test.
- Should I be vaccinated? People who are vaccinated are still getting Covid-19 – Yes, vaccination has been shown to decrease adverse events when someone does acquire the virus.

**Items to Note:**

- These numbers represent the data obtained through the state’s MAVEN system, and do not reflect diagnosis through home rapid tests; assume that the actual positive cases are higher.
- 55 of the 161 cases (47%) in this 2 week review are from 22 households.
- 55 of the 161 cases (47%) in this 2 week review are in the age group of 41 to 60 years old.
- 7 cases out of the 161 cases in this two week period are under 5 years old, and therefore ineligible for vaccine.
- 81% of Andover residents are fully vaccinated; 52% have received a booster shot. Note that persons under the age of 12 may not be eligible for a booster yet.
