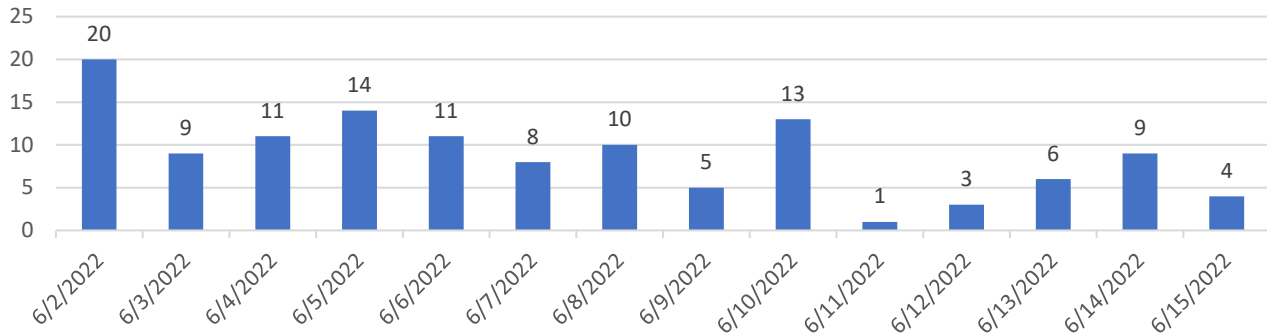

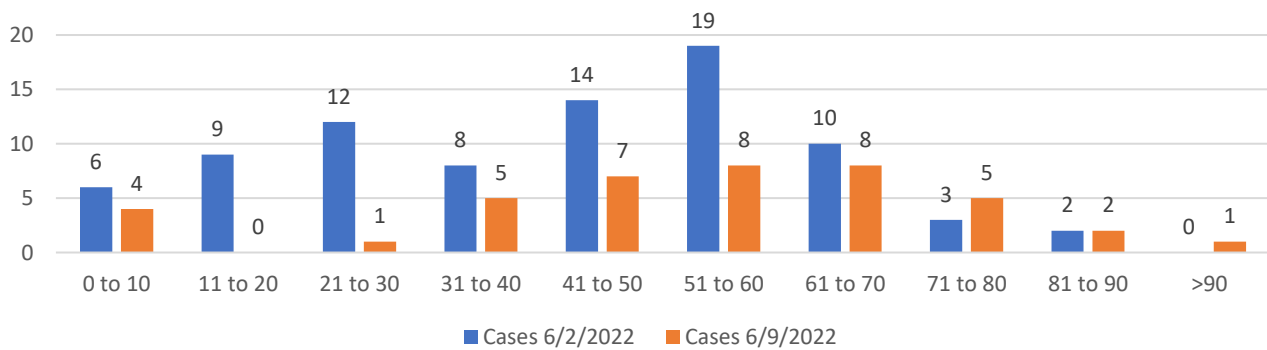

- With the proliferation of use of in-home antigen tests, there are many more cases than those reported here – we report only lab-confirmed cases through the state system.
- Covid-19 treatments are widely available at this time; contact your physician or the state (see link above).
- We remind all that we are in a very different place now than we were 6 months ago. The virus has been less debilitating, our vaccination rates have increased, and there are effective treatments available, allowing most cases to recover with little in the way of complications.
- Residents should watch these numbers and make their own decisions concerning mask use. **However**, if you have tested positive for Covid-19, or are a close contact to a positive case, you should mask in accordance with state guidelines (see the link above).

Items to Note:

- These numbers represent the data obtained through the state’s MAVEN system, and do not reflect diagnosis through home rapid tests; assume that the actual positive cases are higher.
- 45 of the 124 cases (36.3%) in this 2 week review are in the age group of 51 to 70 years old.
- This week (Week of June 9nd) saw a 50.6% decrease in the number of cases when compared to the previous week (Week of June- 2nd)
- 82% of Andover residents are fully vaccinated; 54% have received a booster shot.
