



Haverhill Mainline Site Improvements at Essex and Pearson Street Town of Andover

- Project:** As part of the Haverhill Double Track Project, Keolis Commuter Service and McCourt Construction will be installing a second commuter rail crossing with new signal and track crossing gates at the intersection of Essex and Pearson streets in Andover, Ma. As part of this project Keolis will complete drainage and site improvements in this area which include the removal of the existing drain line; installation of new drainage including catch basins and manholes; new granite curbing, concrete sidewalks and asphalt paving.
- Tentative Schedule:** The duration of this work is approximately 2 months.
- Construction Starts:** **Mid May** – Contractor will mobilize to the site, begin survey, test pits, vacuum excavations.
- June** – the major portion of the work will be done in the month of June. Installation of the new drainage pipe and structures, installation of new sidewalks and the installation of the new track crossing panel.
- Construction Ends:** **Mid to End of July** – final paving, striping and street signage.
- Impacts:**
- Roadway Closures:** **Pearson St** - will be closed (for thru traffic) for a portion of this work
Essex St – one lane will be closed for a portion of this work.
- Full closures** of the intersection of Essex/Pearson/Railroad St will be necessary to complete the installation of the new track crossing panel and for final paving of the intersection. This work will be done on weekends. Proper notice will be given via the town newspapers, social media and by variable message boards in town.
- Commuter Rail Service:** There will be no interruption of Service to the Commuter Rail.
