## BALD HILL COMPOST SITE

The Town of Andover compost site at Bald Hill will be open for Andover residents ONLY. Permit is required.

Wednesdays and Fridays - 12 noon to 3:00pm  
Saturdays and Sundays - 8:00am to 4:00pm

**We are currently only selling permits through our mail-in program until further notice.**

### Permit Fee - Mail in Option

Permits sold to Andover residents only: \$24 for one year or \$72 for three year. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope, copy of the vehicle registration, and check made out to the Town of Andover.

**Residents** may drive in to drop off leaves, grass clippings and brush during the operating hours listed above.

**Residents** MUST remove their yard waste from whatever container is used to transport.

Brush must be clear of any metal, including cable anchors, nails, etc.  
**All contaminated loads will be rejected.**

\*There are substantial fines for **ILLEGAL dumping**.

**Directions to Bald Hill:** Take Lowell St. (Route 133) to Greenwood Rd. (the traffic light just east of the IRS). Take Greenwood Rd. (0.8 miles) north to High Plain Rd., Take High Plain Rd. (1.0 miles) west to Bald Hill.

## CURBSIDE LEAF COLLECTION

The Town of Andover will be conducting Curbside Leaf collection for six (6) weeks in the Spring.



**April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020 - May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020**

### WHAT TO DO

**\*\*NO rocks, stones, branches or stumps**

Place leaves curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular trash collection day (Republic Services will send a separate truck to specifically pick up leaves only)

### HOW TO PREPARE LEAVES FOR PICKUP:

- Place leaves in open trash barrels (leaves ONLY)
- Place leaves in brown paper leaf compost bags
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS IN ANY COLOR ACCEPTED**

### ***BUNDLED BRANCHES***

*Branches are allowed in the weekly trash pickup, (subject to limitation of 3-4 bundles per week) and must be bundled with tape or rope as follows:*

- 1" to 6" in diameter
- 50# or less each
- up to 4' in length
- No foliage
