HOUSEHOLD & BUILDING MATERIALS

Kitchen: Cabinets (must have all doors
and drawers), countertops, sinks and
faucets

Bathroom: Vanities, sinks & faucets, tubs
& enclosures, low-flow toilets, ceramic
tile, accessories (towel racks etc.)



Flooring: Carpeting and carpet tiles, ceramic
and vinyl tiles, sheet vinyl, wood

Lumber, Plywood, Drywall: Dimensional
lumber (6' minimum length no scraps),
moldings, plywood & drywall (half sheets or
larger), house shutters

Electrical: Working and complete, interior &
exterior, light fixtures, paddle fans

Housewares: Dishes, vases, pictures,
collectibles

Tools: Hand or power tools in working
condition, rakes, shovels

Small Household Appliances

Windows: No lead paint, dual pane only
Doors: No rotting or cracks, all panes intact.
No lead paint. Interior (minimum width
30") or exterior, storm doors (with frame
and hardware), hardware (locks, knobs,
hinges)

mantels, porch posts



RECYCLING – Broken is ok (not for donation, reuse, or repurposing)

TEXTILES

Towels, bedding, and linens, curtains, fabric
scraps/yarn, small throw rugs, pillows,
potholders, scarves, wallets, purses,
backpacks, shoes, sandals, watches, jewelry,
**Stained, worn or torn is fine, but NO OIL
OR GREASE STAINS. Must be dry and
bagged.**



ELECTRONICS/APPLIANCES

CRT's- \$10 for regular, \$20 for jumbos

TV's under 50lbs : \$20 - \$30

TV's 50-80 lbs: \$40

TV's 80-100 lbs: \$60

TV's over 100 lbs: \$70

Hard Drive destruction -\$5 per drive

Free: Macs/PCs laptops. Computers/CPUs, servers, LCD monitors,
keyboards, mice/trackballs, servers/server rack, circuit boards,
routers/switches/hubs, printers/scanners, copiers/faxes, cell
phones/PDAs, telephone systems, speakers, CD/DVD/VCR players,
stereo equipment, power cords, cable/strips, tape cartridges, UPS/
