TOYS AND HOBBIES

NO MOLDY ITEMS, BROKEN ZIPPERS, MISSING PIECES

Indoor: Board & card games; Legos; Magnatiles; dolls, dollhouses & furniture; action figures; puzzles; building logs or blocks; toy cars, trucks and racing structures; arts and crafts materials; sewing or knitting tools. **Outdoor:** bats; balls; mitts; hula hoops; jump ropes; sand/water toys; wagons; small basketball hoops; yoga mats; tennis rackets; snowshoes; fishing rods and reels; tackle boxes



CAMPING AND TRAVEL

NO MOLDY ITEMS, BROKEN ZIPPERS, MISSING PIECES

Camping: Camp chairs; Sleeping bags; sleeping pads; tents; tarp; bungee cords; mess kits; lanterns; head-lamps
Travel: Backpacks; rolling suitcases; duffel bags; tote bags



WEARABLE CLOTHES/SHOES

Clothing, shoes, purses in re-saleable condition
Adult and kid sizes only— Must be dry and bagged. **NO BABY/ TODDLER CLOTHING**



BOOKS/CDs/DVDs

Hard & soft cover books; Audiobooks; movies; music records; games. **NO MAGAZINES OR ENCYCLOPEDIAS**



BIKES, ETC.

Bikes; tricycles; tandems; skateboards; ski & snowboards; tools; bike clothes; parts/accessories. **NO USED HELMETS OR SCOOTERS**



FURNITURE

Lamps; kitchen tables/sets; bar stools; dressers; coffee or end tables; bean bags; shoe racks; coat racks; small bookshelves; storage unit; desk; office chairs. Functional; no stains, tears, missing legs. **NO large furniture; upholstered furniture; entertainment centers; pianos/organs; mattresses / box springs.**



HOUSEHOLD & BUILDING MATERIALS

Kitchen: Cabinets (must have all doors and drawers); countertops; sinks; faucets

Bathroom Fixtures: Vanities; sinks & faucets; tubs & enclosures; low-flow toilets; ceramic tile; accessories (towel racks, etc)

Doors: No rotting or cracks, all panes intact. No lead paint. Interior (minimum width 30") or exterior, storm doors (with frame and hardware), hardware (locks, knobs, hinges)

Architectural pieces: Columns, mantels, porch posts

Flooring: Carpeting and carpet tiles, ceramic and vinyl tiles, sheet vinyl, wood



Appliances: less than 10 years old in excellent condition

Lumber, Plywood, Drywall: Dimensional lumber (6' minimum length no scraps), moldings, plywood & drywall (half sheets or larger), house shutters

Electrical: Working and complete, interior & exterior, light fixtures, paddle fans

Exercise equipment

Housewares: Vases, pictures, collectibles

Tools: Hand or power tools in working condition; rakes; shovels; lawn mowers

NO CANS OF PAINT OR STAIN, NO FLUORESCENT BULBS, USED FIXTURES, CEILING FANS, PARTICLE BOARD, WINDOWS, SCREENS, SASHES, COUNTERTOP, OR HVAC EQUIPMENT



HOME GOODS

All in clean and working order

Small appliances (less than 7 years old):

Microwaves; toasters; coffee makers; vacuums; blenders; irons; dorm refrigerators

Kitchen Ware: Plates; bowls; dishes; silverware; pots & pans; teakettles; cutting boards

Linens (usable): rugs, blankets, sheets sets



RECYCLING – Torn and broken okay (items below are not for donation, reuse, or resale)

TIRES

Passenger & light truck tires. **NO RIMS**



TEXTILES

Stained, worn or torn is fine. **NO OIL OR GREASE STAINS.**

Clothing, coats, gloves, hats, belts, scarves, wallets, purses, backpacks, shoes, sandals, watches, jewelry, towels, bedding, and linens
